This half day workshop will introduce you to woodland planning, using the free online tool MyForest. It is suitable for those who are interested in starting the planning process, as well as those who are already using MyForest software.

The Argyll Small Woods Cooperative launched the MyForest Planning software for small woodland owners in February 2016. Since then the Coop, with support from the Forestry Commission, has developed 7 MyForest Plans for members.

This half day workshop will review the MyForest process, plan the next steps for those already engaged in woodland planning, and introduce participants to the process of creating a woodland inventory.
